



Mother Lode Workforce Development Board Scholarship for WIOA Approved Certificate Programs

Purpose: Mother Lode Job Training (MLJT) has teamed up with Amador College Connect (ACC) to offer the Mother Lode Workforce Development Board Scholarship to eligible ACC students. MLJT has dedicated funds to pay for training that leads to industry recognized post-secondary credentials in high demand, high wage jobs. The purpose of the Scholarship program is to support the retention and growth of quality jobs, a skilled workforce, and businesses in our counties.

Eligibility Criteria: To be eligible for scholarship assistance, students must:

1. Be a resident of Amador, Calaveras, Tuolumne or Mariposa counties.
2. Meet the eligibility requirements of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). *See contact info below to discuss eligibility and priority.
3. Be seeking education and certification leading to employment in a high wage, high demand job. All training programs, prior to being considered for a scholarship, must be listed as approved by WIOA on the Eligible Training Provider List (ETPL) found at www.calJobs.ca.gov.

Note: Students enrolled in MLJT's Youth Program may select a training not on the ETPL List with management approval.

4. Meet with MLJT to verify eligibility, complete the WIOA Application, submit a scholarship application for a WIOA Approved training program and receive final approval of the scholarship grant.
5. Meet with an ACC Representative to discuss educational goals, available course offerings and planned classes/area of study.
6. Enroll in the WIOA Approved certificate program and register for classes.

Amount: Scholarships may be used for tuition, fees, and books; scholarships are paid directly to the training provider. Scholarships vary depending on available funding and are not to exceed \$10,000 per student. Travel allowance and childcare can be made available as a supportive service paid by MLJT.

Requirements: Once enrolled, supportive service and tuition funding is based on continued attendance. Students must provide a copy of certificate upon completion. Additional services are made available to assist with employment in a high demand, high wage job.
